“Direct from the Bar – It’s Guys & Dolls” incorporates three tribute shows in one performance. Its success hinges on the ability of the cast to recreate the look, sound and mannerisms of some of America’s greatest performers.

In the early 60s, Frank Sinatra, Sammy Davis Jr., and Dean Martin made history when they teamed up in Las Vegas. Their carefree antics on stage became legendary and earned them the nickname, “The Rat Pack.” Audience members will be transported back in time as they hear classics like “That’s Amore,” “Diamonds are a Girl’s Best Friend,” “New York, New York,” and many more.

During *Together Again*, Dean Martin and Marilyn Monroe will recreate classic performances that are sure to showcase their charisma, charm and chemistry.

Finally, the roles are perfectly cast with Sharon Owens as Barbra Streisand and Sebastian Anaildo portraying Sinatra. Sinatra and Streisand never worked together, except when they taped a duet in separate recording sessions, but fans everywhere always wondered what it would have been like if they had teamed up for a concert tour. *The Show that Never Happened* features “I’ve Got A Crush on You,” the song they both recorded for

Sinatra's Grammy-winning 1993 album, *Duets*, and leaves the audience wondering whether the real stars could have done an even better job.
